

Looking Forward to Peace: Remembrance Day Event

Expression of Interest: Flotilla



To commemorate the centenary of the signing of the armistice that ended World War I, Noosa Council is holding a community event, **Looking Forward to Peace**, in Tewantin Memorial Park on 11 November 2018 from 12noon-4pm. An element of this event will be a re-enactment of the peace flotilla that took place in 1918 when local residents decorated their watercraft and traversed the Noosa River celebrating the signing of the Armistice and the cessation of World War I.

Council is inviting local boat owners or operators to decorate their watercraft and join a flotilla on the Noosa River on Remembrance Day, gathering above Sheep Island, passing Tait's Jetty at the Tewantin Memorial Park around 12noon-12.15pm.

The marshalling of the flotilla will be led and managed by QF5 Noosa Coast Guard.

It is expected that flotilla participants will adorn their craft with bunting and Australiana-themed decorations.
